Information Notes:

The Chilliwack CVI is being hosted during the same weekend as the bronze show. As such there are a few changes from show's that have been hosted by EVA in the past.

Any horses that are cross entered between the Bronze show and the CVI must attend the Vet Check on Thursday, June 10. These horses must remain in the secure CVI Horse section. Horses in the Bronze show only will have a separate stall area, so don't have to complete the Vet Check.

Only lungers, coaches and designated grooms will be permitted to enter the secure stabling area. "Social" areas for clubs will be in another designated area of the facility.

Horses registered only in the Bronze show must provide a certificate of vaccinations from their vet, but do not require an EC passport. Part of the entry fee will be \$3.50/horse for drug testing. Your horse may be chosen randomly to be tested. All horses have to pay the fee.

All information about this show is and will be posted here on this website at www.evabc.ca. We will not accept paper entries for this show, all entries must be submitted online here. A single payment per club must be received by the entry deadline by credit card, or a cheque by ground mail. Waiver forms must be emailed, faxed, or ground mailed.

Memberships

All Canadian vaulters and longers must be members of Equine Canada and hold an Equine Canada Bronze Sports License. Vaulters and longers must also be members of their provincial

equestrian vaulting association. American Vaulters, Coach's and Longers require membership in American Vaulting Association (AVA). Vaulters entering only the Under Age 10 Walk D class, the demonstration class or barrel classes need not purchase a sports license.

Official Rules

All mounted classes, others than those specified below will follow the rules of the Equestrian Vaulting Association of B.C. All classes will **complete one round with separate goes for compulsories and freestyle**. Barrel classes will be 1 minute for individual, 90 seconds for doubles, and 3 minutes for team. A selection of barrels will be used. A mini tramp may be used. Barrel classes will be conducted according to the EVA Recommendations for Barrel Classes at Vaulting Events.

Please note that this competition is a family-oriented event. As such, all vaulters and coaches should ensure that music selections, should they contain vocals, are appropriate for an all-ages audience. Music must be submitted according to the EVA Standards for Submitted Music.

Please ensure that each vaulter is eligible for the selected class(es) by referring to the EVA eligibility rules. If you are unsure about the eligibility of a vaulter for a given class please contact the event organizers.

Cross Entering:

- CVI competitors are welcome to enter barrel classes. Those entering the CVI as individuals may also enter the Bronze show classes for team or pas de deux. Likewise, CVI competitors only entered in team or pas de deux are welcome to enter individual mounted classes in the Bronze Show provided they have never competed as an individual in a CVI.
- We are unable to offer cross entering between Walk, Trot and Canter classes (as outlined in the EVA rules) at this show due to the expected volume of registrations.

Tentative Schedule

Friday, June 11: 5:00 pm onwards Individual Canter compulsories, Team compulsories and Two-Phase Compulsories

Saturday, June 12: All individual and Team Freestyles. Please note that we cannot provide an order of go until the draw for competitors in the CVI. It is planned to offer as many of the bronze show classes as possible in the main competition ring.

Sunday, June 13 - All barrel classes including two-phase team barrel freestyle.

Stabling

Stalls will be set up by 4 pm on Tuesday June 8. Practice arenas will be available starting Tuesday afternoon. You may reserve either a single stall (3m x 3m) or a double stall (3m x 6m). Stalls will cost \$25 per night plus 7% tax. Double stalls are \$50 per night plus tax. There is also a one-time charge of \$20 for the stall mat (\$40 for double stalls) as the stalls are based on a concrete floor; \$10 per stall for shavings; and \$10 per stall for manure disposal fee. You are expected to clean out your own stalls at the end of the competition or your club will be assessed a \$25 clean-out fee by Heritage Park. Tack stalls are also available at a cost of \$25 plus tax per night.
