

AVA Summer Vaulting Camp at Historic Fort Robinson, Nebraska

July 6-12, 2011

Live and breathe vaulting for a full week!

Six hours of daily instruction on both the barrel and the horse, with open horse time that allows for individual practice time. Considerable horse time combined with dance, performance, horsemanship, fitness and conditioning classes will give all level of canter vaulters a fun and intensive week of training.

Coaches will include Brazilian coach and former FEI-level vaulter **Flavia Themudo Guida** and world renowned coach and clinician, **Nancy Stevens-Brown** and a host of others. Vaulters will work on well-trained horses with experienced lungers to provide all vaulters with a safe and fun experience.

Coaches are invited to clinics in: the building blocks approach to compulsory exercises; the creative and technical aspects of freestyle development; how to evaluate your vaulter and focus instruction on the most important elements; how others organize and safely run vaulting programs. Bring your vaulters too for the ultimate week-long teambuilding event!

All participants will swim, hike, trail ride, make crafts, take a field trip, enjoy the rodeo, hayride, and chuck wagon dinner for a complete, authentic **Western experience**.

Fort Robinson State Park has more than 22,000 acres of exquisite Pine Ridge scenery, compelling Old West history, loads of fun-time activities, scenic camping and the park's own buffalo and longhorn herds.

Spots Fill Quickly: Register Early. Space is limited and spots fill quickly. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis according to postmarked dates.

Camp is open to **all AVA vaulters 12 years and older, copper level and up**.

For AVA vaulters and coaches a \$275, non-refundable deposit will save your space for this event of a lifetime. (The balance of \$575 must be postmarked by May 30.)
