

CERTIFIED HORSEMANSHIP ASSOCIATION VAULTING COACH CERTIFICATION PROGRAM - MARCH 4-6, 2012

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How is Certified Horsemanship Association (CHA) vaulting certification helpful to my vaulting program?

A: Certification instills confidence in prospective students that there is an expected level of professionalism and safety in your program. Insurance companies are familiar with CHA and often offer significant discounts to programs with certified instructors.

Q: The information says that CHA offers multiple levels of vaulting coach certification. Which level(s) will be certified in conjunction with the AVA Convention in March?

A: All three certification levels will be offered.

Q: Who will be teaching the certification?

A: Patti Skipton and Kathy Rynning, CHA Vaulting Clinic Instructor and Assistant Clinic Instructor. (See the “bio” section of this website for more information on these instructors.)

Q: I noticed that the certification starts on Friday, March 2 for a small session, and then continues starting Sunday and ending Tuesday. What if I can't attend the short session on Friday night but really want to take the certification Sunday through Tuesday?

A: We will arrange a time for you to “catch up” on Friday night’s material. The benefit of attending Friday night, if possible, is in getting your first lesson assignment ahead of time.

Q: What if I already own some of the course material noted in the information section? May I bring my own and get a discount on the price of the session?

A: If you already have parts of these course materials, please let us know in advance and we will let you use your own material and refund you the materials price after.

Q: Can I still get special convention hotel pricing for Sunday through Tuesday, even though the AVA convention ends on Sunday afternoon?
