AIRLINE/AIRPORTS

The Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport (MSP) serves 32 million passengers a year and is a major hub in the Midwest. It is the home to 29 major airlines including AirTran, Alaska, American, Continental, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Sun Country, United and US Airways, and has many reasonably-priced non-stop and direct flights from all over the United States.

TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE AIRPORT/HOTEL

Least Expensive (\$2.25 each way per person): You may take the light rail and then call for the free hotel shuttle to pick you up at the light rail. Light rail trains run every 10-15 minutes; the trip is 20 minutes from Lindbergh Terminal (airport) station stop to the Metrodome/East Downtown stop. Call the Ramada hotel at 612-331-1900 (as you are leaving Linbergh Terminal) to arrange shuttle pickup at the light rail station. You may also be able to arrange a pick-up ahead of time, inquire at hotel.

Inexpensive (\$19 each way per person): Airport Super Shuttle <http://www.supershuttle.com/Default.aspx>

Taxi option for Small Groups: If you are traveling with a few people, a taxi to the hotel is about \$38 one way. Just go out of baggage claim to find a taxi.

Rental Car: the Travelocity.com website reports rates as low as \$150 for Thursday through Sunday rentals.
